Description: Create a floor childrens maze using Illustrator.

Project: Using Illustrator create a childrens maze.

Copy: You may wish to add a little story (very short) about why you need to get through the maze. Add extra text where necessary.

Presentation: Save as Illustrator file and hand in on the Data Server.
